THE SANTA BARBARA FOUNDATION 2011 WOMAN OF THE YEAR

WHEREAS, Patricia MacFarlane has been selected as the 2011 Woman of the Year by the Santa Barbara Foundation in recognition of the significant contributions she has made to the quality of life in our community;

WHEREAS, Patricia MacFarlane has devoted her time and energy to countless local organizations and causes, focusing her efforts on helping nonprofit organizations become more prepared and strategic when making financial, fundraising and operational decisions; and

WHEREAS, Patricia MacFarlane has volunteered her time and energy in the effort to enhance the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History and Ty Warner Sea Center through her service on the Museum's Board of Directors and its Finance, Development, Governance, and Executive committees. As President of the Board, in 2006, she initiated a strategic planning process that has had a profound effect on the organization and she had significant leadership role in successfully raising \$10 million for the Ty Warner Sea Center and the half-million dollar campaign to restore the Museum's iconic Blue Whale skeleton; and

WHEREAS, Patricia MacFarlane has provided leadership and vision for a number of community organizations that includes being a founding member of the Campaign Cabinet of the American Classic Campaign for the restoration and renovation of the Santa Barbara Bowl, serving on the Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara Board of Directors where she was elected president in 2009 and currently leads the annual effort to raise over \$7million, and she assists the Circle of Friends Children's Center achieve financial stability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Patricia MacFarlane as the recipient of the 2011 Santa Barbara Foundation Woman of the Year Award and further commends her for a lifetime of outstanding leadership and dedicated service to our community.
