Dear Mr. Frye:

Per your e-mail request dated Friday March 11, 2011, regarding the additional work on the Draft Project Report, HDR provides the reasoning for the Amendment #4 budget increase for Task 6C in the amount of \$15,000:

- Additional Submittals: The original project scope assumed a Draft Project Report (DPR) and Final Project Report (PR) submittal. This has evolved into an Admin DPR, DPR #1, DPR #2, and a Final PR. The additional hours for each submittal were not accounted for in the original scope of work and fee.
- Storm Water Data Report: The storm water data report template has changed from our
 initial submittal. Caltrans had updated their SWDR template and, as a comment to the
 October 2010 DPR submittal, they requested HDR to translate all the old information to
 the new template. Caltrans will also conduct one more review of the SWDR, which may
 require HDR to expend additional hours to provide a response, update the SWDR, and
 resubmit.
- 3. Project Schedule Extension: The project schedule extended beyond reasons outside of our mutual control (Caltrans). This has resulted in our extended management and associated overhead costs subsequent to the original termination date of December 31, 2009. The contract amendment #1 extended the contract termination date to June 30, 2011. This request will further change the contract termination date to December 31, 2011. In exchange of your due consideration of items 1 and 2 above, HDR will consider absorbing the costs of this extended project management overhead.

HDR is committed to completing the project but the changing conditions by Caltrans, project schedule creep, and additional submittals have caused strains on the project budget.
