### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Consider Case 08AGP-00000-00004, for nonrenewal by the landowner of an existing agricultural preserve contract. The Board of Supervisors action should include the following:

- A. Accept the request for nonrenewal of Agricultural Preserve 88-AP-032.
- B. Execute the attached Notice of Nonrenewal by the County Land Conservations Contract for Assessor's Parcel No. 001-160-031, located at 7391 Gobernador Canyon Road, in the Carpinteria area, First Supervisorial District.

### Summary Text:

On August 10, 2007 the Agricultural Preserve Advisory Committee (APAC) reviewed the status of the landowner's Land Conservation Contract and found that there was no longer agricultural production on the site. At this APAC hearing, a 5-0 vote was carried to recommend that the Board of Supervisors non-renew this contract based on inconsistency with the Uniform Rules due to the lack of agricultural production. The subject property has been in an agricultural preserve since February 2, 1989. Nonrenewal of the contract will become effective December 31, 2008.

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## Background:

Government Code §51200 (known as the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 or the Williamson Act) provides that local jurisdictions may establish an agricultural preserve program having the goal of retaining land in an agricultural use. The County of Santa Barbara has adopted such a program which is codified under the Agricultural Preserve Program Uniform Rules. Both the County's Uniform Rules and the Government Code provide that agricultural preserve contracts between the County and landowners are voluntary. Therefore, there are no state mandates associated with this program.

Section 51245 of the Government Code provides that if either the landowner or the County desires in any year not to renew an agricultural preserve contract, that party shall serve written notice of nonrenewal of the contract upon the other party in advance of the annual renewal date of the contract. The Agricultural Preserve Advisory Committee's position is that while it does not encourage removal of property from preserve status, it recognizes that pursuant to the Uniform Rules of the County's Agricultural Preserve Program, nonrenewal is an accepted method for terminating a contract when the landowner chooses to withdraw from the program.

The subject property is a 9.52-acre parcel zoned AG-I-10 and shown as Assessor's Parcel Number 001-001-160, located at 7391 Gobernador Canyon Road, in the Carpinteria area, First Supervisorial District.
