Accept the Hutton Foundation's donation of \$20,000.00 for acoustic treatment of the auditorium in the Lompoc Veterans Building.

#### **Summary Text:**

The County of Santa Barbara, through the efforts of the 4th district office, has been awarded a grant for help in the rehabilitation of the Lompoc Veterans Memorial Building. This grant is specifically for the acoustic treatment in the Auditorium.

#### **Background:**

The 4<sup>th</sup> District Supervisorial is working to restore the Veterans Building. To that end, they have initiated a fund raising effort to cover the estimated cost of the \$3.5M for the recommended repairs, safety enhancements and upgrades to the building which resulted from an "Assessment of Conditions Study" that the County had completed. This grant from the Hutton Foundation is the first grant to be received and is intended to help correct the very poor sound qualities of the auditorium and provide a more desirable space for local functions and increase the rental opportunities of the building.
