





Project History

 Montecito Planning Commission approved project on August 16, 2006 by a 4 to 1 vote

 Added condition to remove brick pavers on sidewalk and planters on seawall railing

Maintain simple, low-key design

Policy Consistency

- As conditioned, the project is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan, including the Coastal Land Use Plan & the Montecito Community Plan and applicable Coastal Act Policies
- Coastal Plan Policy 7-1: The County shall take all necessary steps to protect and defend the public's constitutionally guaranteed rights of access to and along the shoreline.
