WHEREAS, to maintain the integrity of this commitment and confidentiality, there is a need for maximum flexibility in the hiring and retaining of the employees in these positions for the County Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:
All persons appointed after the effective date of this resolution to fill future vacancies in Position No. 4888 in the executive secretary function for the County Executive Officer are
exempt from the Civil Service System of the County of Santa Barbara and will serve in the capacity as an "at will" employee subject to the pleasure of the County Executive Officer.
