

## TY OF SANTA BARBARA RESOLUTION HONORING SANTA BARBARA HIGH SCHOOL **CALIFORNIA** UPON THE 100th ANNIVERSARY OF ITS

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara High School is celebrating the 100th anniversary of its student newspaper, The Forge, which the oldest student school paper in Santa Barbara County and the second oldest in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, The Forge debuted in 1914, under the leadership of Editor Henry C. O'Leary and Advisor Waldemar C. Westergaard. That fall, an editorial challenged the student body: "We would like to call the attention of the student body to the fact that we have in The Forge an Open Forum. We are ready and desirous of receiving your opinions on matters that concern our school welfare. If the world does not move to suit you, tell it your reasons in the Open Forum."; and

WHEREAS, this school year of 2014-15, under the editorships of Emma Cisek and Tyler Greenwald and Advisor Otto Layman, The Forge moves into its second century of providing a forum for the students of Santa Barbara High School and it is documenting the first 100 years in a special edition; and

WHEREAS, a celebration of "100 Years of The Forge" is being organized by the Santa Barbara High School Alumni Association and will include: the return to campus of former editors, staff members, advisors, and alumni; a school-wide assembly on Friday, October 17, 2014; and an Open House on Saturday, October 18, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims the week of October 12-18 as 'Santa Barbara High School 'The Forge' Newspaper Week," and congratulates the Santa Barbara High School community and its voice The Forge on its centennial achievement.
