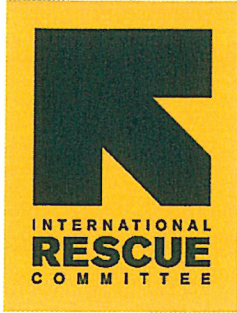

Dear Ms. Miyasato:

Further to my letter of November 8 regarding Executive Order (EO) 13888,\* we have received additional guidance from the State Department regarding the provision of consent by counties. Specifically, written consents should include:

- language indicating the duration of the consent within the body of the consent letter, preferably that the consent is valid until withdrawn; and
- an attachment that lists all the municipalities within the county, signed by the county executive or equivalent.

I have enclosed a revised consent-letter template that includes language about the consent's duration and a new template for the required attachment.
