SUBJECT: Set Hearing to Consider Response to the 2008-09 Grand Jury Report on Santa

Barbara County Employees' Retirement System

Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Set a hearing on the departmental agenda for June 23, 2009 to consider the Board of Supervisors' responses to the 2008-2009 Grand Jury Report entitled "Santa Barbara County Employees' Retirement System."

Summary Text:

On March 15, 2009, the Civil Grand Jury released a report entitled "Santa Barbara County Employees' Retirement System." The report includes six findings and seven recommendations. The Board of Supervisors was named as the Santa Barbara County government responder to finding six and recommendation six. The Santa Barbara County Employees' Retirement System (SBCERS) was also named as an independent Board responder to findings one through five and recommendation one through six. The response to the Grand Jury report is currently being prepared and will be presented as part of the June 23, 2009 Board hearing.

Background:

Per California Penal Code Section 933 (b), the governing body of the agency, the Board of Supervisors, must respond within 90 days after the issuance of the Grand Jury Report. Therefore, the Board of Supervisors' response must be finalized and transmitted to the Courts and the Grand Jury no later than July 10, 2009.
