### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

On March 14, 1995, your Board created the Agricultural Advisory Committee. The composition was to include one appointee by each member of the Board and one member from each of the following groups, to be ratified by the Board:

California Women for Agriculture
California Strawberry Commission
Central Coast Wine Growers Association
Grower-Shipper Vegetable Association
Santa Barbara County Cattlemen's Association
Santa Barbara County Farm Bureau
Santa Barbara County Nursery and Flower Growers Association

At your April 9, 2002, meeting, your Board approved the nomination of alternates to the Agricultural Advisory Committee by each of the member groups for appointment by your Board.

The Central Coast Wine Growers Association has nominated Dave Thompson to replace Lon Fletcher as their representative on the Committee. Dave is the owner of Thompson Vineyards. Lon Fletcher, who has served on the committee since its inception, will remain as an alternate.
