Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Director of Parks to advertise for construction bids for the Rancho Guadalupe Dunes County Park Day Use Improvements; County Project No. D64003:

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project is the construction of day use improvements at Rancho Guadalupe Dunes County Park. The improvements will consist of a paved parking area to accommodate approximately 50 vehicles, a public restroom, picnic and interpretive facilities. The existing dirt and gravel parking area will be removed.

This project requires approval by the California Coastal Commission as the project area is within their original permit jurisdiction. The Coastal Commission will consider approval of this project at their hearing of August 13, 2004. At the time of your Board hearing on August 17, staff will be able to report on the Commission's action, if requested.

Due to the presence of the federally threatened western snowy plovers on the park property, construction is limited to the non-nesting season of October 1 - March 1.

The "Notice to Contractors" will be published prior to the date set for the opening of bids. Sealed proposals to construct this project will be received at the County Parks Administration Office, 610 Mission Canyon Road, Santa Barbara, CA 93105 at a date to be determined and will be opened publicly and read aloud.
