Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors consider recommendations as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement for Claims Adjudication for the Medically Indigent Adult (MIA) Program with CenCal Health for the period of October 1, 2012 to June 30, 2014 for reimbursement for healthcare inpatient claims adjudication for services rendered to MIA patients at local hospitals for a maximum of \$3,200,000 for the term of the Agreement.
- b) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review per CEQA Guideline Section 15061(b) (3), since it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activities may have a significant effect on the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to authorize the Chair to execute the First Amendment to the CencCal Health Agreement for Claims Adjudication for the MIA Program. This First Amendment modifies the sections related to retroactive eligibility for third party payers and delays the implementation of administration fees for this service until October 1, 2013.

CenCal Health Claims Adjudication Agreement, First Amendment

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Background:

This Agreement was approved by your Board on June 26, 2012. Immediately following that authorization, the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Medi-Cal Administration implemented a new policy wherein all retroactive Medi-Cal eligibility claims are to be adjudicated by DHCS rather than through CenCal Health. This First Amendment incorporates the DHCS requirements and adjusts the initial process implementation and the claims administration fees. The initial program implementation has been delayed until October 1, 2012 in order to authorize these operational changes. The remaining Agreement maximums and terms and conditions remain unchanged.

Fiscal Analysis:

The cost for the administration for this service is estimated at approximately \$7,000 annually and will not start until October 1st of Fiscal Year 2013-14. This amount has been included as part of the PHD's Fiscal Year 2013-14 proposed budget.
