WHEREAS, County Board of Supervisors has previously entered into a three-year grant agreement with the California Victim Compensation Board (CalVCB), and desires to continue the program to provide compensation to victims of crime for the financial losses they experience as victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has designated the District Attorney Victim-Witness Assistance Program as a provider of comprehensive services to victims of crime in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, CalVCB is authorized to contract with the Santa Barbara County District Attorney Victim-Witness Assistance Program to provide claims verification services; and

WHEREAS, CalVCB has allocated a total of \$713,892 for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021, or \$237,964 per fiscal year, to implement this project to expeditiously process claims subject to the execution of a Standard Agreement and acknowledgment of the terms and conditions contained therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney of the County of Santa Barbara is authorized to submit Agreement VCGC8059 to CalVCB, and is authorized to execute the Standard Agreement on behalf of the Board of Supervisors.


