Justification: When the 2024-25 budget was adopted it was anticipated that access to the State's Track and Trace software (Metrc) would replace the need for the

California Cannabis Authority (CCA) data platform contract and therefore funds were not appropriated to cover the annual membership fees. This platform provides analytics from Metrc inputs and the cannabis business licensing team uses this information to complement compliance inspections and reviews. Continued access to the data platform is required to provide the level of detail necessary for compliance reviews. This budget revision establishes appropriations for the annual membership fees that will be funded by fees charged to cannabis operators per the ordinance and associated Board approved

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fee schedule.
