## RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS BOARD IN THEIR EFFORT TO IMPLEMENT "BLUE IV"

*WHEREAS, the natural landscape of Isla Vista is composed of beautiful beaches, a blue ocean, and many species of wildlife, all requiring substantial efforts to keep the environment clean through recycling and responsible waste disposal; and*

*WHEREAS, Isla Vista currently has the lowest diversion rate in the County of Santa Barbara, and the curbside recyclables collected in Isla Vista have been increasingly contaminated with garbage; and*

*WHEREAS, UCSB's Environmental Affairs Board members have volunteered much time and effort to establishing the "Blue IV" program which distributes blue-colored recycling bins along Del Playa, organizes volunteers to go door-to-door in an ambitious education program and generates enthusiasm in recycling effort; and*

*WHEREAS, the Environmental Affairs Board has done an excellent job by coordinating with the Isla Vista Parks and Recreation District, UCSB and Associated Students, IV Adopt-a-Block Program, Shoreline Preservation Fund, IV FoodCoop, MarBorg, representatives of local government including an enthusiastic Public Works Department, and members of the community to establish a recycling program that we can all be proud of; and*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that this Board of Supervisors honor and commend the UCSB Environmental Affairs Board for its outstanding commitment to the environment and community of Isla Vista.
