

Mobile Home Park Regulation Summary






Existing Mobile Home Parks

- 18 Parks
- 2,387 Homes
- 4 MHP Parcels with No Development



County's Existing Regulations



Three Ordinances

- Chapter 11 Mobile home building permit and inspection authority.
- Chapter 11A-Rent Control
- Chapter 21 Prohibition on rental to ownership conversions.

Mobile Home Park Closures

Government Code Section 66427.4

- Regulates conversions, which require a subdivision map.
- "This section establishes a *minimum standard* for local regulation..."

Government Code Section 65863.7

- Regulates closures or conversions, which do not require a subdivision map.
- Local agency may require the mitigation of impacts to residents, including "reasonable costs of relocation"




Local Jurisdictions

- Several local jurisdictions have adopted Mobile Home Park Closure Ordinances:
 - City of Santa Maria
 - County of San Luis Obispo
 - City of Huntington Beach
- Such ordinances further define:
 - Contents of the Resident Impact Report
 - Relocation Assistance
 - Permit Procedure
- Most of these ordinances do not regulate conversions from rental to owner-occupied subdivisions.



LRP Work Plan

- The development of a Mobile Home Park Closure Ordinance is included in the 2011-2012 LRP Work Plan as a potential project.
- Ordinance development would require approximately 0.65 FTE.
