WHEREAS, Sue F. Vincent has been an active member of the Assistance League of Santa Barbara since 1988; and was active president from 1999-2000; and

WHEREAS, Sue F. Vincent launched the Fostering Friends Program in 2000 for emancipating foster youth, which today reaches from newborns through emancipation of foster youth; and

WHEREAS, Sue F. Vincent is an active member of the Women's Fund of Santa Barbara where she has been part of the research team since 2010; and is an active member of the Santa Barbara Neighborhood Clinic's Smiles Program, which has taught children and parents about dental healthcare since 2004; and

WHEREAS, Sue F. Vincent served on the Santa Barbara Adult Education Advisory Board for three years in the 1990's, and has taken many Adult Education classes in Santa Barbara since 1969.
