Annual Adjustment of Inclusionary Housing Requirements

The Inclusionary Housing Requirements, per Section 46A-4 of the IHO, shall be reviewed annually by the Community Services Department.

Inclusionary housing requirements for moderate and/or workforce household income categories may be waived entirely by the County when the median sale price of all housing units in each non-exempt HMA over a twelve month period is affordable to either moderate and/or workforce income categories.
