FIRST AMENDMENT TO SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN

COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA,

as Administrative Entity for the Santa Maria/Santa Barbara County Countinuum of Care, and PARTNERS IN HOUSING SOLUTIONS, INC.

This First Amendment to Subrecipient Agreement ("First Amendment") is made and entered into by and between the County of Santa Barbara, a political subdivision of the State of California ("COUNTY"), and Partners in Housing Solutions, Inc., a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation ("SUBRECIPIENT" and, together with COUNTY, collectively, the "Parties" and each a "Party"), with reference to the following:

WHEREAS, the State of California Emergency Solutions and Housing (CESH) Program ("Program") is authorized under State SB 850 (Stats. 2018, Ch. 48 §4) and operates under the requirements of the California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 2.8 of Part 2 of Division 31, commencing with section 50490 and including sections 50490.1, 50490.2, 50490.3, 50490.4 and 50490.5; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT entered into a Subrecipient Agreement effective September 1, 2020 ("Agreement"), for Program funds in the amount of \$229,777; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Period of Performance of the Agreement as set forth therein in Section II.A. "Time of Performance," to extend the termination date to July 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the EXHIBIT B to the Agreement (Budget and Payment Procedures) to revise certain budget line items with no change in the total amount of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, any funds not expended by July 31, 2022, will no longer be available to SUBRECIPIENT; and

WHEREAS, Section VI.E of the Agreement, "Changes or Amendments," provides that COUNTY and SUBRECIPIENT may amend the Agreement at any time provided that such amendments make specific reference to the Agreement, and are executed in writing, signed by a duly authorized representative of each party, and approved by COUNTY's governing body.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section II. A. of the Agreement is hereby amended by replacing Section II.A. to read in its entirety as follows:

"This Agreement shall begin on September 1, 2020 (Operating Start Date) and shall terminate on July 31, 2022, unless suspended or terminated earlier or there is no CESH funding available for any reason. All work to be performed hereunder as set out in the Scope of Services may commence on the Operating Start date, September 1, 2020, and shall be completed by July 31, 2022. Any funds not expended by July 31, 2022, will no longer be available to the SUBRECIPIENT and shall be returned to the COUNTY. If allowable under the CESH Standard Grant Agreement between State HCD and the COUNTY, the Term and the Award Time of Performance may be extended upon written approval of the COUNTY as described in Section VI.E, below."

2. The Time of Performance set forth in Exhibit A of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Time of Performance: September 1, 2020—July 31, 2022"

3. The last line of the Status Reports schedule set forth in Section C.2. of Exhibit A to the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

January 31, 2023"

4. The "Term" set forth in Exhibit B to the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Term: September 1, 2020—July 31, 2022"

5. ATTACHMENT 2 to EXHIBIT B of the Agreement is hereby amended by replacing ATTACHMENT 2 in its entirety with the following:
