RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 4- 11, 2008 AS "NATIONAL 4-H WEEK" IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, for more than a century, 4-H has engaged our country's youth in the building blocks of economic success by providing a solid focus on the agricultural and resource sciences, electricity, mechanics, and engineering and;

WHEREAS, the United States is falling behind other countries in developing its future workforce of scientists, engineers, and technology experts; 4-H, through its out-of school opportunities, is working to address this gap by promoting subjects such as rocketry, robotics, bio-fuels, renewable energy, marine science and computer science; and

WHEREAS, through a public-private partnership, 4-H can focus a variety of resources and expertise to strengthen young people's discovery and exploration of science which will shape their education and career decisions; and

WHEREAS, the California 4-H Youth Development Program—with its direct connection to the research and resources of the University of California's Cooperative Extension — is strategically positioned to strengthen U.S. global competitiveness and leadership; and

WHEREAS, nearly seven million youth touch and enhance the lives of others during National 4-H Week and throughout the year by serving their community, giving where there is a need, rebuilding what had been torn down, teaching where there was a desire to learn, and inspiring those who had lost hope; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors proclaims October 4-11 as National 4-H week in Santa Barbara and encourages all residents to learn about 4-H and the opportunities it provides.
