WHEREAS, *Richard Jenkins, as a member of the specially appointed Assistance to Agencies Committee, helped to identify areas of structural needs within nonprofit organizations and helped to provide training to nonprofits in response to those needs; and*

WHEREAS, *Richard Jenkins, as a member of the Commission, participated in making recommendations that were approved by this Board for grants exceeding \$8,500,000 to human services providers throughout Santa Barbara County,*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED *that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Richard Jenkins for his dedicated and tireless service to the Human Services Commission and to the citizens of Santa Barbara County.*
