Recommended Actions: That the Board of Supervisors:

Set a hearing on the departmental agenda for June 2, 2009 to discuss and consider the Board of Supervisors' responses to the 2008-2009 Grand Jury Report entitled "Los Prietos Boys Camp and Academy."

Summary Text:

On March 18, 2009, the Civil Grand Jury released a report entitled "Los Prietos Boys Camp and Academy" (copy attached). The report includes five findings and five recommendations. The Probation Department and the Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Department are named as the Santa Barbara County government responders to the findings and recommendations. The response to the Grand Jury report is currently being prepared and will be presented as part of the June 2, 2009, Board Hearing.

Per California Penal Code Section 933 (b), the governing body of the agency, the Board of Supervisors, must respond within 90 days after the issuance of the Grand Jury Report. Therefore, the Board of Supervisors' response must be finalized and transmitted to the Courts and the Grand Jury no later than June 12, 2009.
