That the Board of Supervisors:

- Authorize the Purchasing Agent to accept the highest public consignment sale offer to purchase surplus heavy equipment using the consignment sales process with Quinn Company and complete the transaction; and
- b) Determine pursuant to CEQA Guidelines §15378(b)(4) that the above fiscal activity is not a project subject to the California Environmental Quality Act.

Summary Text:

Section 2-47 of the County Code requires approval from the Board of Supervisors prior to the disposal of surplus items with a market value in excess of \$25,000 by the Purchasing Manager.

The Santa Barbara County Fire Protection District intends to submit for public consignment sale one piece of surplus heavy equipment that has an estimated sale price of \$30,000 - \$35,000, and net consignment price of not less than \$27,000. The item is identified as one (1) used 1980 Caterpillar Dozer D7G (serial #91V01624), with 4.961 hours.

Background:

The recommended action will allow the Fire Protection District to dispose of and sell surplus property valued in excess of \$25,000 that is past its useful life and no longer needed by the department. A replacement bulldozer is budgeted this fiscal year and currently on order, with delivery expected soon.
