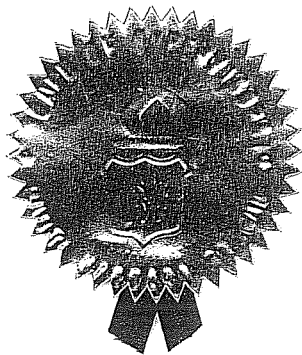

WHEREAS, the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians Foundation desires to celebrate both the giving of grants and those organizations who receive the grants for the benefit of the community by hosting the first annual Chumash Foundation Dinner on Wednesday, October 27, 2010;
