Background:

Santa Barbara County experienced an extensive rain season resulting in significant fuels growth. Additionally, the State has already exceeded average fire activity and acreage so far this fire season. This presentation will review the county's current fire risk, power outage considerations, county wide planning and resources, and most importantly community preparedness considerations.
