**RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing a (4-way) stop control at the intersection of Valencia Road and Banner Avenue in the Summerland area.

**ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN**

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION**

The intersection of Valencia Road and Banner Avenue is a 4-way intersection. An investigation was performed at this intersection to determine whether a 4-way stop was warranted. The results of this investigation show that the installation of a 4-way stop at this intersection would improve public safety for those residing and traveling through the intersection of Valencia Road and Banner Avenue.

Based on our investigation, it was determined that a 4-way stop at the intersection of Valencia Road and Banner Avenue would be appropriate. This item was presented to the Traffic Engineering Committee (TEC) on September 8, 2004. The TEC recommended the installation of the 4-way stop signs. Public Works, Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a 4 way stop control at the following location:

- Stop all traffic entering the intersection of Valencia Road and Banner Avenue.
