- a) Certify that the Board has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration (22NGD-00000-00003) and make the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings required to adopt the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration (22NGD-00000-00003);
- b) Adopt the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration (22NGD-00000-00003) and adopt the Mitigation Monitoring Plan included in the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration (22NGD-00000-00003);
- c) Approve the Project and authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for bids to construct Phase 2 of the Modoc Multiuse Trail; Project No. 862416; Second Supervisory District; and
- d) Authorize the Director of Public Works to proceed with right-of-way acquisition negotiations, including in fee, right-of-way easements or licenses, and/or temporary construction easements, as required for the construction of the Modoc Road Bike Path.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to adopt the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration 22NGD-00000-00003 (MND) and the Mitigation Monitoring Plan, approve the project, authorize right of way work and advertising.

Staff will present information and updates on the project and final draft Mitigated Negative Declaration at the hearing.

Background:

This project is the second of two County phases that will complete the last gap in a multiuse trail that will connect the City of Santa Barbara path to the Obern Trail. Completion of Phase 2 of this project, along with Phase 1 and a City Project near Calle de Los Amigos will create a continuous, separated facility for bicycles and pedestrians of all ages and abilities extending from Isla Vista to Arroyo Burro Beach and the City of Santa Barbara.
