That the Board of Supervisors:

Set a public hearing for June 16, 2020 to consider the following:

- a) Adopt a resolution, effective July 1, 2020, setting the fee schedules for solid waste handling and disposal at County facilities for Fiscal Year 2020/21;
- b) Adopt a resolution, effective July 1, 2020, setting the Parcel Fee Schedule for the Cuyama Valley for Fiscal Year 2020/21;
- c) Adopt a resolution, effective July 1, 2020, setting the fee schedule for solid waste collection rates in the unincorporated areas in Zones 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 for Fiscal Year 2020/21; and
- d) Find that the proposed recommendation does not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b) (5), because it consists of organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to set a hearing to adopt resolutions to establish solid waste tipping fees, collection rates, and parcel fees for Fiscal Year 2020/21. Each year, your Board adopts resolutions establishing fees charged at County-operated solid waste management facilities as well as rates charged by the franchised service providers to collect waste materials from residential and commercial customers. In addition, your Board sets the parcel fee schedule that is assessed to property owners in the New Cuyama Valley to pay for the operation of transfer stations in this rural community. These fees are developed and approved in accordance with Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code. A Board Letter will be submitted prior to the departmental hearing providing the proposed fee schedules for these services and will be available to the public on June 11, 2020 on the County Clerk of the Board's website for the June 16, 2020 Board of Supervisors hearing. Hard copies will be available by June 11, 2020 at the Clerk of the Board's office at 105 East Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara as well as the offices of the Resource Recovery & Waste Management Division at 130 East Victoria Street, Suite 100 in Santa Barbara.

Performance Measure:

The tipping fees, collection rates and parcel fees are based on the cost to provide these solid waste management services.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

There will be changes to the existing fee schedules, which will be provided in detail in the subsequent Board Letter. There are no proposed facility impacts.
