

PROJECT APPLICANT: G&K Farms, LLC

PROJECT LOCATION: The Project is located on a 14.66-acre property, zoned AG-I-10 and shown as Assessor's Parcel Number 005-280-040, located at 3561 Foothill Road, Carpinteria, 1st Supervisorial District, Santa Barbara County.

PROGRAM EIR PROJECT DESCRIPTION (SUMMARY): Consistent with state law, Cannabis Land Use Ordinances would regulated cannabis activities within the unincorporated County. The Cannabis Land Use Ordinances are intended to balance the diverse demands for cannabis products with the public health, safety, and welfare of the community through the enactment of strong and effective regulatory and enforcement controls. The Cannabis Land Use Ordinances would regulated how, where, and how much cannabis and cannabis products may be cultivated, processed, manufactured, tested, distributed, and sold while protecting the environment, neighborhood character, and quality of life for people and communities.

SPECIFIC PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Proposed Project is a request for a Conditional Use Permit (Case No. 19CUP-00000-00062), a Development Plan Amendment to 82-DP-30 (Case No. 20AMD-00000-00003), and a Coastal Development Permit (Case No. 19CDP-00000-00157) to allow for the construction of a new 25,418-square-foot, 25foot-tall cannabis processing building and a detention basin to capture run-off from the structure.

The site is currently developed with five existing greenhouses permitted under the original Development Plan, Case No. 82-DP-30, and one existing warehouse, which was permitted under a Modification to the Development Plan, Case No. 86-M-4. Of the existing 379,757 square feet of development, 356,070 square feet is currently used for cannabis cultivation as approved by Coastal Development Permit, Case No. 18CDP-00000-00077. The proposed processing building will be used for the storage, drying, trimming, and packaging of cannabis grown both on-site and off-site. Up to 50% of the product processed in the proposed processing building will be grown off-site. Proposed grading for the Project includes 1,400 cu. yd. of cut and 1,000 cu. yd. of fill. Other site improvements required include storm water detention and a septic system. No vegetation or trees are proposed for removal.

External lighting will be provided by sixteen wall-mounted full cut-off LED motion detector lights on the east, north, and west sides of the proposed building near doorways. The proposed building includes carbon filters in all processing areas, air curtains on exterior doors, spray insulation within the building, and negative pressure throughout the building to reduce fugitive odors. Existing landscaping along Foothill Road screens the Proposed

Project from view. Two chillers associated with the HVAC system will be installed adjacent to the proposed building. Ten 3,450-gallon water tanks will also be installed.

The proposed cannabis processing building would add up to 50 new full-time year-round employees, for a maximum of 80 full-time year round employees for the entire cannabis operation the property. The Proposed Project will add 18 parking spots, including two ADA spots, and stripe the existing parking area, for a total of 54 parking spots. The operator will lease at least one 15-passenger van through CalVans (or a similar third party company) to provide daily roundtrip weekday vanpool transportation for employees commuting from Ventura County to the Project site for the life of the Project. All employee parking will be on-site and no employee parking on public roads is allowed.

The hours of operation for the processing building will be 6:00 am to 3:30 pm, seven days a week. Two emergency generators will be installed for backup power in case of an outage. Water for the processing building and all domestic uses on-site will be provided by the Carpinteria Valley Water District. The proposed processing building will contain two restroom areas for the use of employees. Wastewater treatment will be handled by a new septic system. Primary access to the site will continue to be provided through an existing easement on the neighboring parcel to the west (APN 005-280-015), which connects to Via Real. The property is a 14.66-acre parcel zoned AG-I-10, shown as Assessor's Parcel Number 005-280-040, and addressed as 3561 Foothill Road in the Toro Canyon Community Plan area, First Supervisorial District.

On February 6, 2018, the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors, as lead agency, approved and certified the final Program Environmental Impact Report for the Cannabis Land Use Ordinances (17EIR-00000-00003, RV01; SCH Number 2017071016), and made the following determinations regarding the Cannabis Land Use Ordinances:

- 1. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 2. The Project will have a significant effect on the environment.
- 3. Mitigation measures (i.e., development standards set forth in the ordinance amendments) were incorporated into the Project, as part of the approval of the Project.
- 4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted for the Project.
- 5. A statement of Overriding Considerations was adopted for this project.
- 6. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 7. A portion of the Project did require discretionary approval from the California Coastal Commission.

- 1. A Program EIR was previously certified for the Cannabis Land Use Ordinances and is used as the basis for this approval.
- 2. Findings and a statement of overriding consideration were previously adopted for the Cannabis Land Use Ordinances.
- 3. The Board used a written checklist pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15168(c)(4) to document the evaluation of the Conditional Use Permit, Development Plan Amendment, and Coastal Development Permit.
- 4. The Conditional Use Permit, Development Plan Amendment, and Coastal Development Permit incorporate all applicable mitigation measures from the Program EIR.
- 5. The Conditional Use Permit, Development Plan Amendment, and Coastal Development Permit would not have effects that were not examined in the Program EIR and pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162, no additional environmental review is required.
- 6. All of the environmental impacts of the Conditional Use Permit, Development Plan Amendment, and Coastal Development Permit are within the scope of the Program EIR and a subsequent environmental document is not required to evaluate the environmental impacts of the proposed commercial cannabis operation.

Project Location: The unincorporated (coastal and inland) areas of Santa Barbara County (excluding Federal lands, University of California lands, and the Channel Islands).

Project Description (Summary): Consistent with state law, Cannabis Land Use Ordinances (the Project) would regulate cannabis activities within the unincorporated County. The Project is intended to balance the diverse demands for cannabis products with the public health, safety, and welfare of the community through the enactment of strong and effective regulatory and enforcement controls. The Project would regulate how, where, and how much cannabis and cannabis products may be cultivated, processed, manufactured, tested, distributed, and sold while protecting the environment, neighborhood character, and quality of life for people and communities.

On February 6, 2018, the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors, as lead agency, approved and certified the final Environmental Impact Report for the Project, and made the following determinations regarding the Project:
