Reasons to support exemption findings: The Board's actions to adopt a resolution and authorize submittal of a grant application to CalRecyle do not constitute a "Project" within the meaning CEQA but are for the purpose of establishing a funding mechanism. The project (Santa Ynez Airport Landfill Remediation Plan) for which the grant application is being submitted was the subject of a CEQA Notice of Exemption approved by the County Public Works Department and filed at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors on June 8, 2005. The project was found to be categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15330 (Minor Actions to Prevent, Minimize, Mitigate or Eliminate the Release or Threat of Release of Hazardous Waste or Substances). The landfill site is highly disturbed and no

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sensitive wildlife, plants or other resources are present. The landfill would be capped using material present at the airport site. No substantial changes in the project, the environmental conditions or anticipated impacts have occurred since the NOE was approved and filed in June 2005.
