## **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Amend BC-12-052 to reflect the acquisition of G4S Justice Services, LLC by Sentinel Offender Services LLC by updating the provisions of the Agreement pertaining to Designated Representative and Notices effective May 1, 2012, through June 30, 2014.

#### **Summary Text:**

On July 1, 2011, the County of Santa Barbara contracted with independent contractor, G4S Justice Services, LLC to provide electronic monitoring equipment and services to Probation. On May 1, 2012, Sentinel Offender Services, LLC acquired G4S Justice Services, taking on all of the duties and responsibilities under the terms and conditions of BC-12-052.

#### **Background:**

Electronic Monitoring utilizing radio frequency technology between a transmitter worn by an offender and a receiver connected to the telephone line in the offender's home monitors the presence or absence of an offender within a specified range. This information is sent over the telephone lines to the monitoring computer and compared to the agency's defined schedule restrictions to determine the offender's compliance. Any issues of noncompliance are immediately reported in accordance with the criteria established with Probation. Compliance and system status

Alcohol Testing utilizing fuel cell technology combined with digital photograph imaging match an offender's breath test and photo identity enables immediate reports of offender's intoxication level to Probation.

The Drive by Unit (DBU) is a hand held device that detects the presence of an ankle transmitter. This device is taken into the field and used to help locate a participant that is within 50 to 400 feet.
