RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING
THE WEEK OF APRIL 21 THROUGH APRIL 28, 2012
NATIONAL INFANT IMMUNIZATION WEEK
AND THE MONTH OF MAY 2012
TODDLER IMMUNIZATION MONTH

WHEREAS, children need a series of vaccinations, starting at birth, to be fully protected from 14 potentially serious diseases; and

WHEREAS, immunizations are among the best ways parents and caregivers can protect their children against vaccine-preventable diseases; and

WHEREAS, getting infants and toddlers immunized on time helps protect the community at large and plays a pivotal role in keeping all Californians healthy; and

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County can be proud to be part of California's "I choose" campaign which uses pictures and voices of local advocates and community leaders to promote immunizations; and

WHEREAS, together we need to continue to educate parents and caregivers about the importance of timely childhood immunizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County does hereby proclaim the week of April 21 through April 28, 2012 as National Infant Immunization Week and the month of May 2012 as Toddler Immunization Month.
