 The most common concern I hear from our constituents is the Affordable Housing Issue, and, here in Carpinteria the lack thereof. I work closely with large tech companies such as LinkedIn, Agilent, Procore, and others the main concern is finding adequate talent to complete their Teams. With UC Santa Barbara and other Universities being nearby, the tech companies are interested in hiring new grads, however the graduates cannot find housing or afford housing nearby.
 If employers bring in talent from other cities, keeping them happily here is an issue due to cost of living.
 Parking is also an issue for the large employers.
