WHEREAS, The mission of the North County Rape and Child Protection Center is to reduce the incidence of and vulnerability to sexual assault and child abuse by providing education and prevention skills to community children and adults; and

WHEREAS, They provide children and adults with instruction on rape and child abuse awareness, self-defense, personal safety and prevention skills in order to decrease their vulnerability to assault and abuse; and

WHEREAS, The program provides school based ChildSAFE (Safety and Awareness for Everyone) programs, which consist of 2-3 day workshops. Additional workshops are provided to parents and teachers to instruct them on child abuse prevention and recognition; and

WHEREAS, Community based programs include self defense workshops and volunteer training/public awareness programs. They reach approximately 12,000 children and adults each year with their education and prevention programs. Program services are available in both English and Spanish and are provided throughout Northern Santa Barbara County including Lompoc, Guadalupe and Santa Ynez Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors declares NORTH COUNTY RAPE CRISIS AND CHILD PROTECTION CENTER, as the FOURTH DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR WOMEN SERVICE AWARD RECIPIENT.
