#### **Recommended Actions:**

On September 20, 2011, set hearing for October 4, 2011 to consider the recommendation of the Montecito and County Planning Commissions, to approve Case Nos. 10ORD-00000-00007, 11ORD-00000-00020, and 11ORD-00000-00021 which would amend the County Land Use and Development Code, Montecito Land Use and Development Code, and the Coastal Zoning Ordinance requirements for commercial Medical Marijuana Collective/Cooperative (MMC) Storefronts.

# A. Case No. 10ORD-00000-00007 (County LUDC Amendment)

- 1. Make the findings for approval of the proposed ordinance amendment;
- 2. Determine that the adoption of this ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act in compliance with Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- 3. Approve Case No. 10ORD-00000-00007, an ordinance amending Section 35-1, the Santa Barbara County Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.

## B. Case No. 11ORD-00000-00020 (Montecito LUDC Amendment)

- 1. Make the findings for approval of the proposed amendment;
- 2. Determine that the adoption of this ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act in compliance with Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- 3. Approve Case No. 11ORD-00000-00020, an ordinance amending Section 35-2, the Santa Barbara County Montecito Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.

## C. Case No. 11ORD-00000-00021 (Coastal Zoning Ordinance Amendment)

- 2. Determine that the adoption of this ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act in compliance with Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- 3. Approve Case No. 11ORD-00000-00021, an ordinance amending Article II, the Coastal Zoning Ordinance, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
