#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors set a hearing for August 9, 2011 (time estimate 60 minutes; 15 minute staff presentation) to consider potential actions which could be taken in response to these two bills. Detailed recommendations and related analysis will be provided to the Board in the August 9, 2011 Board Letter.

#### **Summary Text:**

On June 28, 2011, Governor Jerry Brown signed into law new legislation known as ABX1 26 (i.e. the "Dissolution Bill"), that eliminates all California Redevelopment Agencies including the Santa Barbara County Redevelopment Agency, effective October 1, 2011. In addition to ABX1 26, companion legislation known as ABX1 27 (i.e. the "Continuation Bill") would allow Redevelopment Agencies to continue operations if the Board of Supervisors accepts the provisions of ABX1 27 and certain payments to the State and local taxing agencies are made (an initial one-time payment and then subsequent annual payments).
