Executive Summary and Discussion:

Per Government Code 31522.1 and 31522.3, the Santa Barbara County Employee's Retirement System Board of Retirement has plenary authority to establish job classifications and salary compensation for employees hired by the Retirement Board. On December 14, 2005 the SBCERS Board of Retirement approved these classification and compensation actions. This request for Board of Supervisor's approval is the mechanism required to include these classification and compensation actions in the County of Santa Barbara's salary resolution.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The increased costs from these actions will be paid from the SBCERS budget per government Code Section 31580.2. There will be no direct impact to the general fund as a result of these actions. The new position allocations will be paid from salary savings for unfilled positions this fiscal year and will increase costs approximately \$47,964 per year thereafter.
