SUBJECT: California Environmental Protection Agency Unified Program Surcharge Rates

Informational Item Only:

Your Board needs only to accept and file; no action is necessary. This is a State surcharge. The State surcharges are listed in the Unified Program Resolutions and are updated by the State on an annual basis.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

Santa Barbara County Fire Department, Fire Prevention Division implements State mandated hazardous materials control laws throughout Santa Barbara County under the auspices of the Unified Program administered by the California Environmental Protection Agency (Cal/EPA).

In May and June of 2003 Cal/EPA public noticed the proposed state surcharge increases for the Unified Programs. Based on consideration of the comments received during the comment period, Cal/EPA determined that the proposed rates are necessary and reasonable costs of the State Agencies with Unified Program responsibilities.

The State surcharge is an assessment on each entity regulated under the Unified Program used to fund the necessary and reasonable costs of all State Agencies responsible for program implementation, ongoing maintenance, and oversight of the Unified Program.

The State surcharge is collected by the fire department through Santa Barbara County Resolutions Nos. 03-167, 03-168 and 03-169 which provide for the collection of the State surcharge by the fire department.

The final rate increases are posted in the California Regulatory Notice Register (Register 2003, NO. 38-Z, titled <u>Notice of Unified Program Final Surcharge Rates For Fiscal Year 2003/2004).</u> The new rates are as follows*:

Hazardous Waste Control	\$17.50	\$24.00

UST Program Oversight	\$10.00/tank	\$15.00/tank

^{*}The new fees above become effective November 18,2003.
