Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the <u>Quitclaim Deed Agreement</u> releasing the County's easement interest in a portion of Assessor Parcel number 004-003-003; and
- B. Find that the proposed Quitclaim execution is exempt under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, Section 15301, pertaining to the minor alterations of existing facilities. Direct staff to file the Notice of Exemption with the Clerk of the Board.

Summary Text:

If executed and recorded the Quitclaim will release the County and the Flood Control District interest in an easement burdening a portion of 4385 Foothill Road in Carpinteria (APN 004-003-003). This action is being taken in response to the land owner's request and in compliance with language in the Grant Deed which created the subject easement. The approximate shape and location of the easement is shown on the exhibit attached to the Quitclaim.

Background:

The subject easement was granted to the County and the Flood Control District in 1967 for use in the construction and maintenance of the Santa Monica Creek flood control channel via a Grant Deed recorded in Book 2198, Pages 739-745. The Grant Deed contains language requiring the County and the District to quitclaim the easement in the event those agencies are no longer using the easement. Flood

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Control representatives visited the site and acknowledge that the subject easement area has not been used by the County for many years. Thus Flood Control has agreed to process the requested Quitclaim.

On March 2, 2011, the Planning Commission determined that the proposed Quitclaim is in conformity with the County's adopted General Plan. The proposed Quitclaim is in conformity with applicable CEQA guidelines. Real Property published a notice of intent to inform the public of the date of this proposed Board action.
