That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing a (2-way) Stop Control on Burlington Drive at Old Mill Lane in the Orcutt Area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure and Goal #5: Maintain and enhance the quality of life for all residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

The intersection of Burlington Drive and Old Mill Lane is a 4-way uncontrolled intersection. In May 2004, a request was received to install stop signs on Burlington Drive at Old Mill Lane. An investigation was performed at this intersection to determine whether stop signs were warranted. The results of this investigation showed that sight distance is restricted on the southwest corner of this intersection and a slight curvature in the roadway. Based on our investigation, it was determined that a 2-way stop on Burlington Drive at Old Mill Lane would be appropriate. The Public Works, Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a 2way stop control at the following location:
