

Answer to questions 12 and 13:

I am interested in serving on the CWS Taskforce because I have a long-standing interest in issues concerning children, with a particular interest in at-risk youth and in general, young people in need of advocacy. For the past decade I have served as a Member of the Board of Directors for the Alliance For Children's Rights, a non-profit organization based in Los Angeles dedicated predominantly to advocating for children in and aging out of the Foster Care System. I have also served as a member of the Montecito School District Board of Trustees for the past 4 ½ years, and for 2 ½ I have served as its President. Montecito is a community in which, for the most part, the children are well advocated for by parents and other committed caregivers. I strongly believe that every child deserves to have this level of advocacy. I applaud the Supervisors in Santa Barbara County for their leadership on this issue, and setting aside the time and resources to thoughtfully assess our County's Child Welfare System in an effort to assure that we are doing the best job possible for our most vulnerable stakeholders.
