RE:

HEARING - Consider recommendations regarding an Amendment to Section 32-21 of the County Code to include collection enforcement options for Transient Occupancy Taxes (TOT), as follows: (EST. TIME: 5 MIN.)

- a) Consider the introduction (First Reading) of an Ordinance amending Chapter 32 Taxation, Article II. Transients, Sec. 32-21 of the Santa Barbara County Code authorizing the Treasurer-Tax Collector to use specific actions to collect delinquent TOTs, penalties and interest;
- b) Read the title (Ordinance Amending Chapter 32 Taxation, Article II. Transients, Section 32-21 of the Santa Barbara County Code to Include Collection Enforcement Options for TOT) and waive further reading of the Ordinance in full; and
- c) Set a hearing on the Administrative Agenda of July 16, 2024 to consider recommendations, as follows:
- i) Consider the adoption (Second Reading) of an Ordinance amending Chapter 32 Taxation,
  Article II. Transients, Sec. 32-21 of the Santa Barbara County Code authorizing the
  Treasurer-Tax Collector to use specific actions to collect delinquent TOTs, penalties and interest;
  and
- ii) Determine that the above actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA Guidelines because they consist of government fiscal or administrative activities which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.
