

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO SET SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES AND SEWER SERVICE CHARGES FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA 12 IN THE MISSION CANYON AREA

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:

ARTICLE I

Section 1.

The following sewer service charge is hereby set for County Service Area 12.

Section 2.

The sewer service charge, including the costs of operation and maintenance, in County Service Area 12 shall be THREE HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND TEN CENTS (\$312.10) annually for each residential unit and each residential unit equivalent.

ARTICLE II

Section 1.

The following connection charge is hereby set for the use of facilities or lines of County Service Area 12.

Section 2.

The connection charge for the use of the public community sewer system in County Service Area 12 shall be FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$5,633.00) for each residential unit or residential unit equivalent. Such connection charge shall not be applied to any building or parcel which has been fully assessed as part of the Mission Canyon assessment district or any other assessment district proceedings for construction of sanitary sewer facilities.

ARTICLE III

Section 1.

The Board of Supervisors may determine by resolution the manner and place of collection and payment of said sewer service charges.

ARTICLE IV

Section 1.

The sewer service charges specified in Article I hereof shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner, and subject to the same penalties and priority of lien, as county taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of county taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the charges, as provided in Section 25215 et seq. of the Government Code.

Section 2.

For the purpose of collecting the sewer service charges on the tax roll, the sewer service charges specified in Article I hereof shall become operative and effective for fiscal year 2019-2020 and shall continue in effect and be operative for each fiscal year thereafter, or as modified by subsequent ordinances.

ARTICLE V

Section 1.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days from the date of its passage; and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it or a summary of it, shall be published once, with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara.
