### FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor, BC No. 23-042, is made by and between the County of Santa Barbara (County), a political subdivision of the State of California, and Fighting Back Santa Maria Valley (Contractor), a California non-profit corporation with an address at 201 S Miller St Ste 209, Santa Maria, CA 93454, for the continued provision of services specified herein (hereafter, First Amended Agreement).

**WHEREAS**, Contractor represents that it is specially trained, skilled, experienced, and competent to perform the special services required by County, and County desires to retain the services of Contractor pursuant to the terms, covenants, and conditions referenced herein;

WHEREAS, County and Contractor (collectively, the parties) entered into an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor, BC No. 23-042, (Agreement) for the provision of substance use prevention services for a total maximum contract amount not to exceed **\$638,664**, inclusive of \$159,666 per fiscal year, for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to amend this Agreement to add Federal Award Identification Tables for FY 24-25 and FY 25-26 with no change to the total maximum contract amount and contract term.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Notwithstanding any other payment provision of this Agreement, County shall pay Contractor for satisfactory services performed to the date of termination to include a prorated amount of compensation due hereunder less payments, if any, previously made. In no event shall Contractor be paid an amount in excess of the full price under this Agreement nor for profit on unperformed portions of service. Contractor shall furnish to County such financial information as in the judgment of County is necessary to determine the reasonable value of the services rendered by Contractor, the decision of County shall be final. The foregoing is cumulative and shall not affect any right or remedy which County may have in law or equity.

- **III. Effectiveness.** The terms and provisions set forth in this First Amended Agreement shall modify and supersede all inconsistent terms and provisions set forth in the original Agreement. The terms and provisions of the original Agreement, except as expressly modified and superseded by the First Amended Agreement, is ratified and confirmed and shall continue in full force and effect and shall continue to be legal, valid, binding, and enforceable obligations of the parties.
- **IV. Execution of Counterparts.** This First Amended Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each of such counterparts shall for all purposes be deemed to be an original, and all such counterparts, or as many of them as the parties shall preserve undestroyed, shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
