FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT RECEIVING THE
U.S. GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL CENTRAL COAST CHAPTER'S
2015 GREEN SCHOOL/ GOVERNMENT AWARD**

WHEREAS, the Community Services Department Remodel has earned the Central Coast Green Building Council's 2015 Green Schools and Government Award for "contributions in making sustainable communities available to everyone within this generation"; and

WHEREAS, the Central Coast U.S Green Building Council recognizes outstanding sustainable building achievements along the California Central Coast, with the "Green Awards" highlighting innovative design, construction, products, businesses, schools, governments and educational programs in our community; and

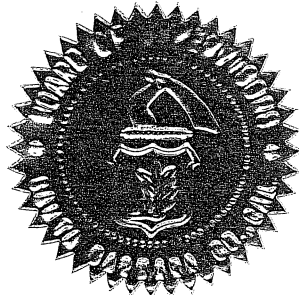
WHEREAS, this project was completed under the leadership and management of General Services Capital Projects staff and also included DMHA Architects, MEC Mechanical Engineers, JMPE Electrical Engineers, GRD Construction, Smart Office Interiors; and

WHEREAS, the Community Services Department remained committed to implementing new concepts and technologies to their proposed offices within the Engineering Building, and partnered with the design and construction team towards a successful project completed on time and on budget which have resulted in energy efficient systems that translate to annual energy savings of roughly 40% over traditional commercial office space; and

WHEREAS, the Community Services Department Alterations Project renovated 4,663SF of aging office space within the Engineering Building of the County's downtown Santa Barbara campus, adding state of the art mechanical systems, replacing dated interiors with bright modern finishes, utilizing recycled content flooring and other renewable materials consistent with sustainable design principles, and adding colors inspired by County Park settings. The introduction of natural daylight into virtually all interior spaces and work areas was key to the transformation story. The project represents a fresh, cost effective, and energy efficient office space upgrade that serves as an innovative model for the future of County of Santa Barbara facilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors, honors the design and construction team, and further commends them for their leadership in energy-efficient building design.
