AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL LEGAL SERVICES

For ATTORNEY services to be rendered under this Agreement <u>between</u> <u>October 16, 2013 and October 15, 2014</u>, ATTORNEY shall be paid a total contract amount, including cost reimbursements, not to exceed \$25,000.

In all other respects, the AGREEMENT remains unchanged and in full effect.
