Purpose of Amendment

- Fulfill the technical requirement necessary to recognize the realistic number of new units that could be built in Isla Vista.
- Revise the County's current RHNA shortfall downward from 1,235 units to 370 units and concurrently redefine the scope of the corresponding state-mandated rezone program.

Background

- 2005-2008: New housing capacity in Isla Vista anticipated all along, but not counted in Housing Element sites inventory.
- August 2007: Following Board adoption of the Isla Vista Master Plan, final Housing Element certification requested from SHCD.

Background

- November 2007 March 2008: Dialogue with SHCD to quantify realistic number of new units.
- June 2008: SHCD directs County to amend the Housing Element and concurrently implement a Focused Rezone Program.
- August 27, 2008: County Planning Commission votes 5-0 recommending that the Board adopt an amendment to the Housing Element.
