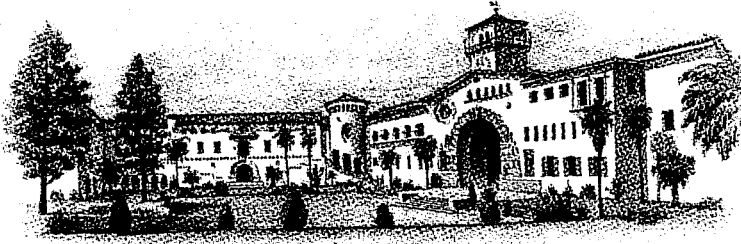



12. EXPERIENCE

I am interested in the Trustee position because of my abilities to serve and willing to work on improving the services of the Santa Maria Cemetery with the other Board Trustees. I am also willing to listen, analyze and make decisions, without bias, and in the best interest of District's citizens. With many family members and friends buried in the cemetery I would like to continue and improve the cemetery's image for current and future use. My main experience for this position of Trustee has been my past positions with the City Of Santa Maria as Transit Administrator, served on numerous organizations as president and on the board of directors, and currently board member of the Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens.

13. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

I have been a volunteer for numerous organizations for the past 40+ years. It started as a member of the Santa Maria Valley Jaycees in the late 1960s. I am a past President and held most of the lower offices. I was also a past District Governor and past State Chairman for elections. I was selected as a U. S. Jaycees Ambassador in 1969. I was sent to Puerto Rico, Costa Rica, and Nicaragua.

I was employed by the City of Santa Maria for 35+ years, starting November 1964 and retired May 2000. I held various positions in the Engineering Division and retired as Transit Administrator. After my retirement, I was asked to assist in managing the Transit Section until my position was filled. I am still doing consultant work for Santa Maria Area Transit on a limited basis. My training and education has been in both technical and management areas.

As an employee of the City of Santa Maria, I am past president of the Misc. Employees Association, past President of the City of Santa Maria Employees Credit Union, past President of the Cuesta Chapter of Federal Credit Unions. I was also past president of City Employees Chapter of the National Management Association. After taking the required courses and passing the tests, I became a NMA Certified Manager.

After retiring from the City I volunteered as an instructor for the AARP Driving Program Classes. I have been a volunteer instructor for 5 years. I also volunteered for the AARP tax assistance program in 2005 and been a member of AARP for 12 years.

In 2004 I volunteered to serve on the Memorabilia Sub-Committee of the City of Santa Maria Centennial Committee. I served on this sub-committee working the Centennial trailer and selling memorabilia at numerous locations and events until September 2005.

I am currently the City of Santa Maria's representative of the Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens Board of Directors
