On behalf of Acciona Energy, we are requesting a 60-day continuance of the Board of Supervisor's consideration of the California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) Appeal of the County Planning Commission's approval of the Lompoc Wind Energy Project and corresponding Environmental Impact Report (Case Nos. 06EIR-00000-00004; 06CUP-00000-00009; 08VAR-00000-00003). Acciona believes a 60-day continuance would provide the time necessary to continue to work cooperatively with CDFG to resolve CDFG's concerns raised in its appeal. Moreover, CDFG has represented its interest in a 60-day continuance to Acciona. Currently, Acciona continues to actively participate in the County's facilitation process with CDFG and believes that a mutually agreeable outcome will be reached if a 60-day continuance is granted.
