 - \$24,000 new agreements at Lake Cachuma
 - \$12,000 Dog Wash Stations at Waller Park and Arroyo Burro Beach
 - \$15,000 new revenues associated with Orcutt
 Community Park rentals
 - Total new revenues \$201,000.00

- Departmental Reductions
 - Department re-organization eliminating Parks
 Operations Manager and creation of
 Maintenance Supervisor. \$24,000.00
 - Reduction of one Mechanic/Welder Position. \$86,000.00
 - Unfunding Vacant Ranger II and backfilling with Part-time staff. \$55,000.00

- Departmental Reductions (cont.)
 - Reduction of contracted tree trimming services
 County-wide. \$14,000.00.
 - Elimination of Purchases of Mutt Mitt dog waste bags. \$15,000.00
 - Reduction of contracted maintenance, San Marcos Foothill Preserve. \$10,000.00
 - Total Reductions to meet 10% \$204,000.00
